Strategic Goals

- Bridge the gap between research insights and real-world change
- Provide additional support to promising FCDO-funded research
- Focus on demonstrated success or clear potential for impact
- Maximize impact of research

Position within Research Commissioning Centre

- Part of RCC's commitment to maximizing FCDO research value
- Complements existing research funding mechanisms
- Day-to-day operations managed by dedicated Fund team
- Streamlined application and review processes

Pilot phase

- Approximately £170,000 allocated to Impact Fund
- Working directly with FCDO Research and Evidence Directorate (RED)
- Targeted outreach to potential applicants from existing programs
- Testing various aspects of fund operations

Eligibility criteria

- Connection to FCDO: Recent, past, or present FCDO-funded research
- Additionality: Not duplicating existing funding
- Impact Potential: High likelihood of significant real-world impact
- Timeframe: Activities feasible within 6-12 months
- Budget: Funding request within £30,000

Assessment Criteria

- Impact Potential (40%): Clarity and significance of expected outcomes
- Feasibility (30%): Practical and robust implementation plans
- Additionality (20%): Creating new value beyond existing work
- Team and Partnerships (10%): Capability to deliver impact

- Relevance to FCDO research objectives
- Diversity of projects and applicants

Review Process Optimization
